



RockReef Parent Participant Waiver

- All participants will be required to wear the safety equipment provided by RockReef, where applicable.
 - Participants must ensure their equipment is in good working order, where applicable.
 - Children under the age of 16 years old must be accompanied by an adult/responsible person over the age of 16 at all times, unless we have the necessary consent form from the child's parent or legal guardian.
 - Participants must listen to the instructions given and follow instructors' directions at all times.
 - Participants need to be dressed appropriately for the activities. Loose articles or objects which could become entangled in the safety equipment or fall on a person below must be removed prior to starting the activity.
 - Jewellery must be removed prior to starting the activity.
 - The consumption of alcohol before or during any activity is strictly forbidden. Anyone found in breach of this rule will be removed from the premises
 - Appropriate footwear must be worn at all time while in the building.
 - All participants are required to act responsibly and courteously at all times. Failure to adhere will not be tolerated.
 - Participants should not attempt to use any piece of equipment or perform a manoeuvre that they feel is beyond their skill level.
 - All activities demand a degree of agility, strength and stamina. If participants are in any doubt about their ability, they are advised to speak to a member of the RockReef staff, who will advise them on their suitability.
 - Participants must make the RockReef team aware of any medical or physical issues that may limit their enjoyment of any of the RockReef elements.
 - New users and beginners to RockReef are advised to familiarise themselves with the layout of the facilities, including making note of all signage around the building.
 - RockReef reserves the right to refuse entry to any persons without explanation.
