
Consultation process for New School Uniform

From September 2020, it was agreed that a new school uniform would be introduced for West Moor Middle School students. The new school uniform design will draw on the school's close proximity to the moors and leafy surroundings through the introduction of green into the colour palette.

The uniform consultation process involved a number of different stakeholders, including all children, parents/ carers, Governors and the parents/ carers of children from our feeder schools. The options were as follows:



These two uniform options were displayed during in the school's Reception for all stakeholders to view during open viewing sessions over the course of half a term. Votes were then cast and for the girls Option B (green blazer and tartan skirt/grey trousers with a revere shirt) was the preferred choice by far and for boys Option A (green blazer and grey trousers with a shirt and tie) was the preferred choice.

Following this consultation process, the new uniform at West Moors Middle School from September 2020 will look like the following:



NOTE: The new uniform will be phased in over time. It will be compulsory for our incoming Year 5 children in September 2020 and thereafter. For existing children, in Years 6-8, this new uniform will be optional and they can, if they wish continue wearing the 'old' school uniform.
