Virtual Cross Country Challenge and Team Competition

We are pleased to announce that West Moors Middle School took part in two Virtual Cross Country Events: PEDSSA Cross Country School Challenge and the PEDSSA 5000m Advanced Team Challenge.

Cross Country School Challenge

This event is to support schools in providing opportunities for children to run (and or walk) their age appropriate distance, with the collective distance covered by each school being recorded and shared to create a Poole and East Dorset total.

Advanced Team Challenge

5 runners complete 5000m by each completing 1000m. This can be done in relay fashion or the five runners complete their 1000m at the same time and their times added together to create a team 5000m time. A team consists of 5 children of the same sex from the same key stage. We are very proud to share that the winning class was 6CW with a time of 24 minutes and 52 seconds.


