Covid Update

I am glad to say that the spike in Covid cases we had before half term has now passed and cases in school continue to decline. Many pupils aged 12+ will have had a vaccination or have some immunity because they have had Covid themselves. However, this is not yet the time to let our guard down and we have had several cases of staff, who have been double jabbed, still getting Covid and feeling very poorly as a result. Please may I ask that we continue to do all we can to look after each other, staff and children, by wearing a face covering in communal areas for a little while longer. This is in line with latest Public Health Dorset advice but continues to be reviewed. Please also continue with the regular twice-weekly LFD testing.

Odd Socks Day

Nationally, Odd Socks day takes place on Monday 15th November 2021. This is the first day of Anti-Bullying Week to help raise awareness of bullying. On Monday, all we want our children to do is to wear odd socks! This is a great way to celebrate what makes us all unique in Anti-Bullying Week and throughout the week, this will form the focus of assemblies and tutor times, aligned to our school's emphasis on the importance of kind words and kind actions, taking care of each other.

Keeping us all safe online

In line with many schools nationally, we have become aware Tik Tok accounts being used to make rude or disparaging comments about others and in some instances fake accounts have been set up, mimicking schools' official accounts across the country. This is simply not acceptable and is considered to be online harassment and cyberbullying. We have told pupils that if they have set up such an account this must be taken down immediately. If a child has followed such an account, they need to unfollow it. Any inappropriate and/ or fake accounts will be reported to Tik Tok, the police informed and the child will be subject to disciplinary action in line with the school's behaviour policy.

I would be grateful if you would check your child's social media account and if you have any information relating to such accounts, please report it immediately to your child's tutor. Please can I ask parents and carers to check and ensure that they know what their child is accessing online, taking appropriate measures if required, to help to keep them safe.
